Wind Strength	Rated at 45 mph <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Commonly will withstand up to 60 mph on smaller (8x10) openings. 	Often fail below 30 mph
Operations	Hand Roll or Rope & Pulley <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete articulation on all 4 sides of curtain Complete wind & rain blockage Complete debris, mold, dust & pollen blockage 	Horizontal Slide or Weight-Bar System <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Curtain panels don't seal completely at top and/or sides Gaps allow wind, rain & cold in Horizontal slide gaps appear at the top Weight-bar system gaps at the sides allowing debris, wind, rain to enter enclosure
Anchoring	D-Rings <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Curtains secured at multiple points Extra strength & security for strong winds Low profile D-rings for foot traffic safety 	Snap or No Anchors <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unanchored curtains flex and tear in mild winds Snap systems don't allow for shrinkage Unanchored curtains lead to costly patio repairs
Panel Size	Up to 12' high or 12' wide* <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Over 100 years of combined manufacturing experience allow us to offer the largest panel size that promotes customer safety & user ability Can zip together to span widths of up to 60' Wider size prevents need to add posts Easily operated by single staff member 	Added-Risks & User Difficulties <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Competitors who don't limit curtain sizes on manual curtains risk extensive damage & the safety of restaurant patrons Too-large curtains will require multiple staff members to operate
Window Size	Up to 10' high or 12' wide* <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bigger, wider outdoor patio Window-free option to hide unsightly scenery 	4'5" high & 9' wide <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Restricted views Many competitors unable to do clear-to-clear seam, limiting window size
Fabric	Vinyl <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Made for strength Handles weather & friction better than cloth fabric 	Cloth <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Often deteriorates from sun and abrasion Even premium canvas brands only last 5 years
Seams	Welded Seams <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Vinyl-to-vinyl construction Reinforced strength at highest stress points See-through clear-to-clear seams Bar Welder / Sonic Weld 	Stitched Seams or Lower-Quality Weld <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stitched perforations (like notebook paper) causes rips in even slight winds Rolling Heat Sealer can cause clouding or bubbling in seam
Service	Nationwide Service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Service provided after the sale Multi-unit customers able to standardize product over multiple locations 	Regional Service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Smaller, local companies Unable to standardize product over multiple locations due to geographic limitations

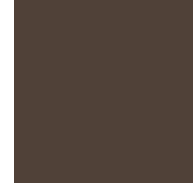

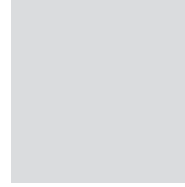
